


Meet Our Team

CARDIOVASCULAR DISEASE

Cardiovascular disease (CVD) refers to any disease that affects the coronary arteries, heart valves, muscles and tissues of the heart, or the heart's electrical system. More than 1 in 3 Americans has some form of CVD.

ANGINA

Angina is a symptom of heart disease. It occurs when there is not enough blood flow to the heart muscle. Symptoms of angina include chest pain or pressure, or a strange feeling in the back, neck, jaw, upper belly, shoulders, or arms.

ATHEROSCLEROSIS

Atherosclerosis is a complex disease that often starts during childhood and progresses slowly. It occurs when fatty substances build up on the inner lining of an artery.
