November is [Diabetes Awareness Month](#), which is dedicated to recognizing the medical condition and those who live with it daily.

In honor of the Diabetes Awareness Month, here are 10 facts you might not know about diabetes.

1. Approximately **one-third** of people with diabetes do not know they have diabetes.
2. Type 2 diabetics often **do not** have symptoms.
3. Only around **five percent** of people with diabetes have type 1 diabetes.
4. Those who are at risk for type 2 diabetes **can prevent** the condition with moderate weight loss (around 10-15 pounds) and 30 minutes of moderate daily exercise, such as walking.
5. Meal plans for people with diabetes **do not** greatly differ from those without diabetes.
6. Diabetes is the **leading** cause of blindness in adults.
7. Diabetics are **twice** as likely to develop heart disease compared to people without diabetes.
8. Proper diabetes control significantly **reduces** the risk of complications and worsening complications.
9. **Bariatric surgery** can reduce the symptoms in obese diabetics.
10. Annually, diabetes costs **\$174 billion**, including **\$116 billion** in direct medical expenses.
