## Conditions Treated

### LYME DISEASE

Lyme Disease occurs when a tick infected with *Borrelia burgdorferi* bacteria is attached to the body for an extended period of time (usually 2 days). Symptoms are similar to the flu or mononucleosis.

### PNEUMONIA

Pneumonia is an infection or inflammation in the lungs. It may be caused by infection with bacteria, viruses, mycoplasmas, or fungi. Some symptoms include chills, chest pain, cough, and nausea.

### URINARY TRACT INFECTIONS

A urinary tract infection occurs when bacteria infect the urinary tract. Women are more susceptible to this than men. Symptoms include frequent urination, pain while urinating, cloudy urine, and fatigue.
