**IRMC Physician Group Pulmonary/ Critical Care Medicine** refers to the medical specialty dealing with the causes, diagnosis, prevention, and treatment of diseases affecting the lungs. It is considered a branch of internal medicine, and is related to intensive care medicine.

Pulmonary/ Critical Care Specialists are specially trained in diseases and conditions of the chest. In particular, they can treat conditions such as pneumonia, asthma, tuberculosis, emphysema, and complicated chest infections.

Dr. Imran Bajwa, our board-certified pulmonologist/ intensivist, has extensive training and has been practicing in the community for many years. He is the Medical Director of Respiratory Services and the Sleep Disorders Center. Additionally, he is Director of IRMC'S Intensive Care Unit, which provides care for patients who are in the diagnostic or treatment stages of life-threatening or potentially life-threatening illnesses or injuries. These include conditions such as sepsis, shock, cardiac arrest, life-threatening infections, and severe respiratory failure.
